




CAR ACCESS

Whether you're travelling from the city centre or the outskirts, you can access Koszorúslány Street via the **Budaörsi Road** intersection.

When leaving the building's P1 level, turning left at the intersection with the traffic lights, the city center and the outskirts of the city can be quickly reached via the intersection, and turning right, Péterhegyi Road provides a connection to Egér Road.

For **Phases 2** and **3** of the Budapest ONE office building, it is best to approach from the **Boldizsár Street side**.

The underground car park allows you to move from one phase to another.



PARKING USAGE GUIDE

I. Download application

Parkl is available for both Android and iOS

II. Registration

 Fast registration in the app with just a few details (email address, number plate, phone number, bankcard details)

III. Instant parking


- Automatic entrance and barrier opening in the car park without using your mobile phone
- Turn on the INSTANT PARKING service on the app's Settings/Cars page and provide your number plate
- The process is then automatic, with the help of a number-plate recognition camera

IV. Start parking via your phone

- On the map, tap on the icon of the Budapest ONE car park
- Tap on the "Start parking" text, then select the right entrance
- Press the "Entrance" button in front of the gate

V. Stopping parking

- At the exit barrier, tap the buttons on the top of the screen for parking details/to complete parking
- · Select the "Exit" button to open the barrier
- With instant parking, the gate opens automatically.
 After leaving the car park, the app will send you a notification
- Payment is effected automatically using the registered card. You will receive a receipt about the parking via email

















- Rooftop running track: In A and B Towers, take the lift to the 8th floor, then take the stairs to the roof to access the track. In C and D tower, the lift travels directly to the running track (9th floor/rooftop). There are changing and shower facilities on the P2 floor in B tower, and P1 floor in C and D tower. Please note that the running track is to be used at your own risk. The running track is available solely to people who work in the office building.
- Bicycle storage facilities: On level P2 in A and B towers, on level P1 in C and D towers
- Bicycle maintenance facilities: On level P2 in A and B towers, on level P1 in C and D towers
- Showers, changing room: On level P2 in B tower, on level P1 in C and D towers
- Electric car charging point: all tenants can find electric car charging points in their own parking spaces in the building. Contact the building operator for use.
- Smoking: In the designated areas, in front of the side lobby in A and C tower, minimum seven and a half metre from of all entrances, operable windows (facade) and building air intakes
- Other: Shoe polish machine, battery storage, water coolers at reception





- Futureal is a founding member of the Hungary Green Building Council (HuGBC), a professional platform and community that has been active in all areas of the building industry since 2009. We provide professional advocacy on current and future issues to achieve a sustainable built environment. As a member of the international community of the World Green Building Council, we provide a knowledge base and platform to raise awareness and for educational activities that builds on forward-looking international practices and the knowledge, as well as the experience and innovative solutions of our members.

The building has already received the BREEAM Very Good rating for Phase 1 and BREEAM Excellent for the design phase for Phase 2 and 3 and is in the process of earning the highest possible WELL rating. The building complex was also the first public project in the country to receive WELL Core Health and Safety Rating.





The British Building Research Establishment (BRE), which developed and operates the BREEAM system, has made the rating system available on international markets since 2008. The system groups sustainability criteria into nine categories, providing a holistic way to measure the performance of a certified project. The criteria typically follow European or national standards. New-build projects are typically rated in two stages, the design stage and the post-construction stage.



The WELL certification from the United States is one of the most up-to-date international certification systems available in Hungary. This scheme differs from, for example, the BREEAM certification in that it focuses specifically on the design and assessment of healthy and more liveable indoor spaces. For this reason, the developers of the WELL Standard explicitly recommend that, in addition to the WELL certification, the entire project to be certified should also be rated according to one of the green building certification systems. The new version of the WELL rating system sets out basic requirements and recommendations for creating a better indoor environment in ten areas: air quality, water, nutrition, light, movement, thermal comfort, acoustics, use of materials, the mental environment and community. It is also possible to obtain pre-certification in the design stage, which allows the project to be identified as a health-promoting building at an early stage. At the end of the project, after verification of the documentation submitted, the project receives the final rating following on-site inspections, measurements and sampling.





BE KIND TO THE ENVIRONMENT: RIDE YOUR BIKE TO WORK!







DID YOU KNOW...

- ... an average car emits 20-80 tonnes of CO2 into the air during its entire life cycle, and not only when you step on the accelerator!
- ... vehicle emissions are a major contributor to the increase in the concentration of climate change-causing gases in the atmosphere!
- ... pollutants contain large amounts of substances that cause cancer or harm the respiratory system; children between the ages of 0 and 4 are most at risk!
- ... 300,000 people die every year in the EU as a result of ultrafine particle emissions from cars!

Do not get into the car for short trips, because fuel consumption and CO2 emissions are much higher when the engine is cold!

WATER IS THE SOURCE OF LIFE

DID YOU KNOW THAT...

- ... water is one of the most important elements of the biosphere!
- ... it covers 70% of the Earth's surface, but only 2.5% of it is fresh water!
- ... more than 1.1 billion people on Earth do not have access to fresh drinking water, and 2 billion live in inadequate sanitary conditions, which causes 5 million deaths every year!
- ... in Hungary, the average water consumption is 100 liters per person per day!

HOW YOU CAN HELP...

Do not run the tap unnecessarily!

Start the washing machine and dishwasher when it is full!

Take a quick shower instead of a bath!

When using the toilet, small buttons are for small things, big buttons are for big things...













EVERY SHEET OF PAPER WAS BORN A TREE

DID YOU KNOW THAT...

- ... more water is needed to produce a ton of paper than to make any other product!
- ... the paper industry is the third largest sector in terms of fossil energy use, and the chlorine used to bleach paper is also extremely harmful to the environment!
- ... an old tree produces 200 kg of oxygen more than one person needs for a year!

DID YOU KNOW THAT...

- ... old-style light bulbs waste 95% of energy!
- ... poor lighting can also impair the efficiency of your work and cause headaches, eye pain, drowsiness, dizziness, back and neck pain, and general fatigue!
- ... if you use a desk lamp instead of ceiling lighting, you don't consume electricity unnecessarily and you can see even better!

HOW YOU CAN HELP...

When you leave the room, turn off the light after you!

Use compact fluorescent lighting or switch to LED!

Don't 'overlight' your surroundings, strive for optimal lighting













HEALTHY BODY, HEALTHY SPIRIT!

DID YOU KNOW THAT...

- ... indoor air quality has a significant impact on your health!
- ... houseplants filter out carbon dioxide and improve indoor air quality!
- ... the evaporation of materials and furniture found indoors can also be harmful to your health!

Keep your environment clean, you can avoid many infections by washing your hands frequently!
